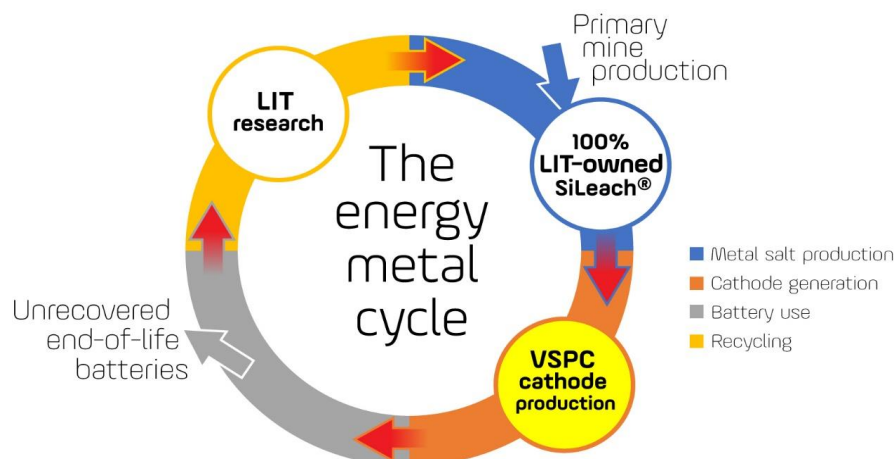

LITHIUM AUSTRALIA NL (ASX: LIT) PRESENTS AT 121 IN CAPE TOWN

Lithium Australia NL (ASX: LIT) will participate in the 121 Conference in Cape Town South Africa on 5 and 6 February 2018. LIT will outline sustainability in the energy metal cycle to use:

- Its 100% owned SiLeach[®] lithium recovery technology; and
- the Very Small Particle Company (VSPC) cathode material production technology; to reduce the emission profile of the energy metal cycle.

Utilisation of mine waste, and the recycling of battery metals are key components of “cradle-to-grave” product stewardship. The technologies controlled by LIT lead the way in sustainability of the energy metal cycle.



Lithium Australia has committed to a lithium chemical pilot plant with a design output of 2,500 tonnes per annum of Lithium Carbonate Equivalent.
