Announcement clarification

The ASX has requested clarification of the location of plant and equipment operated by Lithium Australia's subsidiary, Envirostream Australia P/L. As announced on 29 November 2019, the upgraded processing facility has been constructed and commissioned and optimization of the process stream is ongoing. The plant is located in Campbellfield in Victoria, providing improved cost efficiency. The Board confirms that it continues to comply with ASX Listing rule 3.1
